Disney Dining 2027:

A simple overview of how Disney dining works, including the difference between paid plans, the Free Dining offer, and the return of the Deluxe Dining Plan.

★ What's New for 2027

- **Deluxe Dining Plan has returned** (3 meals per day, any combination)
- Snacks are now **Anytime Treats**
- Table-Service meals include **one alcoholic OR speciality drink** for adults
- More **character restaurants** accept dining plan credits
- **Mobile Order** available at selected table-service restaurants
- Kids' meals have **more flexible sides**
- Refillable mugs now work at **all Disney resort hotels**



Paid Dining Plans (What You Can Buy)

Quick-Service Dining Plan

Includes per person, per night:

- 2 Quick-Service meals
- 1 Anytime Treat
- Refillable Resort Mug

Best for: Fast, flexible, on-the-go families.

Disney Dining Plan

Includes per person, per night:

- 1 Table-Service meal
- 1 Quick-Service meal
- 1 Anytime Treat
- Refillable Resort Mug

Best for: Families who want character dining or sit-down meals.

Deluxe Dining Plan (Returned for 2027)

Includes per person, per night:

- **3 Meals** — any combination of Quick-Service or Table-Service
- **2 Anytime Treats**
- Refillable Resort Mug

Best for:

- Foodies
- Families wanting multiple character meals
- Guests who enjoy signature dining
- Anyone who wants maximum flexibility

Free Dining Offer (What You Receive for Free)

Disney assigns the plan based on your resort category.

Resort Category	Free Plan You Receive
Value	Quick-Service Dining Plan
Moderate	Quick-Service Dining Plan
Deluxe	Disney Dining Plan

*(The Deluxe Dining Plan is **not** part of the Free Dining offer.)*

- **Disney Dining Plan**
- **Deluxe Dining Plan**
