Grandparents get quiet spaces.

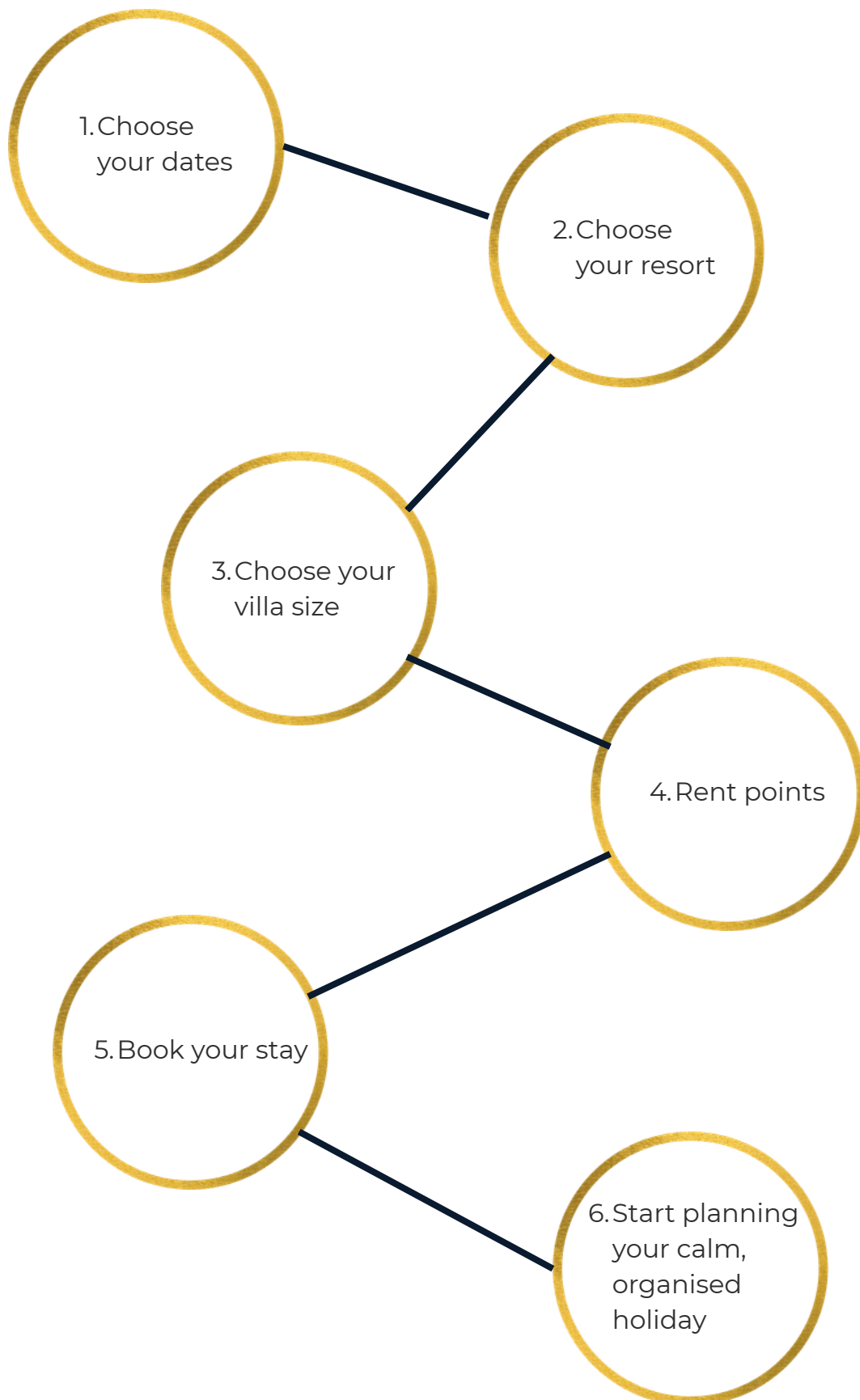
Teens get their own beds.

Slow wake-up.
Familiar breakfast.
Kids play in the living room.
No rushing.
No overwhelm.

A Multigen Decision Made Easy

One 2-bedroom villa instead of two hotel rooms.
Cheaper. Easier. Calmer.

A Common Mistake & Fix

Mistake: Booking a standard hotel room for a 10-night UK trip.
Fix: Renting DVC points for a villa — more space, better value.

Mistakes to Avoid

1. Trying to plan everything at once
2. Thinking DVC is “too complicated”
3. Booking the wrong resort
4. Leaving point rental too late
5. Assuming villas are “luxury only”

Quick Wins

- ✓ Book early — villas fill fast
- ✓ Choose Saratoga Springs or Old Key West if unsure
- ✓ For multigen, look at 2-bedroom villas
- ✓ For SEND, choose calmer transport resorts
- ✓ Use a trusted rental partner
